

## Creating Observer Accounts & Pairing With Student Accounts



An "observer" is merely a generic term Canvas uses to describe a parent or guardian that would like to observe their student's coursework on Canvas. Observers can merely observe and cannot manipulate or turn in assignments.

## To Create an Observer Account (WEB):

I. Go to the URL <u>https://dexterschools.instructure.com/login/canvas</u>

2. Click on the link titled "Parent of a Canvas User?."


3. Fill in the necessary account information and create a password. The student pairing code at the bottom is a unique code generated for each student. The pairing code is explained on the opposite side of this handout.

## Locating the Student Pairing Code

- 1. Ask your student to login to Canvas (all student accounts are active and students have already had a brief tutorial).
- 2. Click on "Account" in the upper left, then "Settings."



3. Click on "Pair with Observer"
